Glenarty Road, Margaret River



Glenarty Road is a boutique farm and vineyard based in Karridale, southern Margaret River. Their focus is to make world-class wine, grow fresh seasonal produce & raise grass-fed lambs. Both the Kerfuffle and Glenarty Road wines are hand crafted from Ground to Glass to ensure that what you taste are wines that are downright delicious, packed full of plush fruit and crunchy acidity. At Glenarty Road they like to do things a little differently. They love the term agricultural, they see it as a way of thinking laterally and being responsive to what mother nature throws at them.

Their fifth generation family farm has its roots in Karridale, the most southern grape growing sub region in Margaret River. With 240 acres of fertile land, things just want to grow there. The farm is a tapestry of fresh, seasonal produce where they harvest over 250 fruit trees, numerous vegie patches, a hop garden with 17 different cultivars and graze a few thousand sheep.

From Owner/Winemaker Robert Gherardi:

At 27 I decided to take the plunge a jump ship in career and commenced my winemaking and viticulture degree completing a full undergraduate program. It was whilst studying that I applied for my first job in the industry with the esteemed Moss Wood winery and vineyard in Margaret River, one of the most highly regarded producers of Cabernet Sauvignon in Australia. A part time summer job in the vineyards tending the old vines by hand lead into an offer to stay on through harvest in the vineyard and winery. I stayed with Moss Wood through my studies and eventually worked with them full time as assistant winemaker for a further 2 years after completing my studies.

Keen to extend myself and increase my learning and experience I moved to Brown Hill Estate, taking up the position of Assistant Winemaker for the 2009 vintage. After this I was hired as Assistant Winemaker at the prestigious Cullen Wines. This marked my first exposure to more traditional and natural fine winemaking techniques, as Cullen is completely biodynamic and produces amongst Australia's best Cabernet and Chardonnay wines, and was a pleasure to learn under one of Australia's leading winemakers Vanya Cullen.

During the 3 years with Cullen I had the opportunity to work my first vintage abroad with the world famous cantina of Elio Altare in Barolo, Italy. To this day Elio remains a friend, mentor and inspiration to me. "

Vinden Wines, formerly known as Vinden Estate, was founded in 1990, and is now under the guidance of second-generation winemaker and viticulturist Angus Vinden. All of their wines are handcrafted at the winery on Vinden Estate, with minimal intervention on-site, from hand-picked grapes. Since taking over in 2015, Angus has maintained the original label, Vinden Wines, which possesses a traditional Hunter Valley style as well as producing his offshoot label allowing a more experimental approach The Vinden Headcase - balancing tradition with innovation. In 2020, Angus' The Vinden Headcase Experimental Release saw the beginning of a life long photography project. As an avid photographer, during lockdown Angus decided to capture a self portrait to represent the 2020 vintage. Over the years, you'll be able to line up all of the bottles and see how he ages both as a man, and evolves as a winemaker. **Organic, biodynamic, minimal intervention.**

Back in 1989 a Kiwi girl met a West Aussie boy whilst working in Melbourne. A common love of travel saw them work and travel overseas together for a few years, before returning to Melbourne where they got married, bought a house and celebrated the birth of their son – Bailey.

During these years they also discovered a shared love of all things to do with wine. In early 1997 they embarked on a ‘tree change’ – relocating themselves and their son, closer to family and to a 10 acre property near Harvey. This place would become Vineyard 28 – with the first vines planted in the Spring of 1998.

Some 23 years later and the property now boasts an extensive vineyard planted mostly to the Italian varieties, Arneis, Brachetto, Fiano, Dolcetto and Nebbiolo along with some Muscat Petit a Grain and Cabernet Sauvignon. During this journey their daughter Gabrielle joined the family in 1999. ‘28’ is the colloquial name for the Port Lincoln Ringneck here in WA, apparently due to their contact call – a whistled “twen-ty-eight” which can be heard across the south-west forests. When planting the first vines these cheeky little parrots were a bit too helpful, snacking on new shoots. Thus it was decided to take their name for the property.

KABAJ

Kabaj began after French winemaker Jean Michel Morel met his wife Katja Kabaj. After the pair got married, they decided to begin to bottle wine from the Kabaj estate instead of selling the grapes. The decision has paid off. Kabaj has regularly been named in *Wine & Spirits Top 100 Wineries of The Year*.

Their wines are unique, beautiful and released after years' of aging. The Kabaj family cultivates 12 ha of vineyards, at two sites in Brda (Šlovrenc, Belo). A major part, up to 70%, is white, dominated by Ribolla Gialla and Tokai Friulano, or Ravan in Slovenian. Their white grapes also include Pinot Blanc, Pinot Gris, Sauvignon and Malvasia. Their red grapes are dominated by Merlot and they include Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot as well. They practice sustainable wine production - vines are fertilised with barn horse manure and are grassed. **Organic, Minimal Intervention**

Bodegas Mitarte is a small family run winery founded in 1982 by D. Santiago Gil Garcia and is the result of the long experience in wine making which has been passed down through the family. Bodegas Mitarte is managed by D. Santiago Gil and his sons. Antonio is the Director and Ignacio is the wine maker. Bodegas Mitarte makes its Rioja wines with grapes from their own vineyards. They have more than 40 hectares of vineyard located around the town of Labastida in Rioja Alavesa. Approximately 15 hectares of the vineyard are old vines which are over 80 years old. The grapes are selected from their own vineyards and only the best grapes are brought to the winery to make their wines. Time is taken to slowly harvest the grapes during the last sunny days at the end of October in order to obtain perfect ripeness of the grapes and therefore top quality wines.

Cain Vineyard & Winery (formerly known as Cain Cellars) is located high in the forested Spring Mountain District with a somewhat isolated location away from most of the other Spring Mountain wineries. The winery was founded in 1980 by Jerry and Joyce Cain and presently produces between 10,000 and 20,000 cases per year. The winery is situated on a ridge line in the Macayamas mountains; as with other Spring Mountain hillside wineries they sometimes receive snow in the winter. The vineyards range in elevation from about 1400 to 2100 feet with these uppermost vineyards among some of the higher vineyards found in Spring Mountain. Their total acreage is significant; five hundred in total of which about ninety are planted to vine. Their water source comes from the rainfall each year; two ponds on property store water for use throughout the season on the vines as needed. Springtime is a wonderful time to visit this winery as there are many picturesque flowers in bloom around the main building including dogwood, azaleas & rhododendrons.

Their flagship wine is the Cain Five which is a blend of the five classic Bordeaux varieties each of which is planted in their vineyards. This is the wine they are most known for – it has been produced since 1985 and is hand crafted down to the smallest of details. The name also ties in well based on the fact they had 5 children.

He is also dedicated to finding vineyard sites that display particular identities that can be passed on through the resultant wines that are produced.

Peay Vineyards is a family-run business started from scratch in 1996. They planted the first 30 acres of the 54 acre vineyard in 1998 with the remaining planted in 2001 and 2008. They grow and produce estate-only Pinot Noir, Syrah, Chardonnay, Viognier and Roussanne/Marsanne. 2002 was the first vintage. Peay Vineyards is a first generation family winery started in 1996. Husband and wife, Nick Peay & Vanessa Wong, grow and make the wine and brother, Andy Peay, sells the wine and runs the business. Vanessa Wong was formerly winemaker at Peter Michael Winery. They sell fruit to a handful of premier wineries, but a majority of their fruit goes into their own bottlings. The Peay family farms organically and maintains their certifications for fish-friendly farming and integrated pest management. The health of the vineyard dictates these approaches to farming and making wine. They also run on bio-diesel at the vineyard and solar power at both the vineyard and winery.

Philip Togni, Napa Valley - NEW ARRIVAL

In 1981, while still employed at Cuvaison, Philip began planting his own vineyard on Spring Mountain and it is here that he has cemented his legacy. Starting with the 1983 vintage he has produced an unbroken string of world class wines; age-worthy, classic, and incredible. Although Philip is still very involved, since 2007, his daughter Lisa has taken the lead more and more. The good news is that she shares her father's gift for winemaking and shows no interest in changing anything at this venerable estate.

The Estate vineyard at Togni is 10.5 acres (divided into 20 blocks) planted to 82% Cabernet Sauvignon and the rest Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. The vines are co-planted and the wine is co-fermented. The soils are a mix of rocky volcanic and clay.

From this single vineyard Philip and Lisa produce three wines: the flagship Philip Togni Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon, a second label Cabernet Sauvignon, Tanbark Hill, and a rare dessert wine, Ca' Togni. The Cabernet Sauvignons are made using barrel selection and are otherwise handled exactly the same. All fruit is 100% destemmed, fermented in stainless steel and aged for 20 months in 40% new French oak. At this point the decision is made of which lots are blended into the "Estate Cabernet" and the "Tanbark Hill". The Ca' Togni is a wine unique to Napa, made from Black Hamburg, Togni's quarter acre of vines produce an aromatic, concentrated, sweet red wine unlike anything else we have come across. A true estate, the wines are made, bottled, and stored just feet away from the vineyard.

Storybook Mountain Vineyards, Napa Valley - NEW ARRIVAL



Storybook Mountain Vineyards (Seps Estate) is one of Napa Valley’s northernmost wineries (almost to the Sonoma County line north of the town of Calistoga). The winery and vineyards are located far from all the traffic and tasting rooms commonly found further south; this is a quiet and peaceful part of Napa Valley. One comes to Storybook for several reasons; its history, the relaxed and informative tastings – but mainly one comes for the premium Zinfandel. Most Napa wineries who produce Zinfandel perhaps only offer one or two wines from this variety; Storybook is one of Napa Valley’s few wineries where Zinfandel is the core of their production.

Storybook is an extremely historical winery; one of the three famous Napa Valley “Jacobs” originally founded it in the 1880s, Jacob Grimm, who was later joined by his brother Adam. The other two famous Jacobs were Jacob Schramsberg and Jacob Beringer, both of whom founded well-known Napa wineries in their own right. The Grimm’s were from family that has been and still is involved in the wine industry dating back to 1540 (in Germany). During the 1880s Zinfandel was one of the varieties planted on site.

The property is 120 acres of which some 43 are planted to vine of which these vineyard acres are organized into 105 unique blocks. Initially the Seps planted the property entirely to Zinfandel (with the advice of one of Napa’s most well regarded viticulturists, André Tchelistcheff) and only produced wines from this variety for 2+ decades, but over time they learned that certain parts of the land was more suited to other varieties and today about 20% of their vines are non Zinfandel including their only white variety, Viognier. The oldest vines on the property date from 1976. One of their blocks is highly unique for Napa Valley – planted in double rows, essentially a row of grapes with two vines in tight spacing planted directly across from each other.

Bob and Jim Varner started planted beginning in 1980, they take a non-interventionist approach to both growing and winemaking in order to express best the individual blocks. Bob farms the vineyard and makes the wine in a deliberate, careful rhythm. They look for purity, focus, balance and terroir. Indigenous yeast and malo-lactic fermentations, gravity flow, minimal sulfur dioxide and esquivé racking are important parts of the process.

Bob and Jim Varner believe that the best wines come from winemakers who grow their own grapes. Therefore, in order to create the most expressive wines possible, the Varner's use traditional cellar equipment and creatively translate centuries-old winemaking techniques and attitudes learned from well-known French family winemakers. The winery at the vineyard is entirely devoted to the production of handmade, Santa Cruz appellation Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

My focus is on the cool, coastal vineyard sites of California's Central Coast. I also love and am inspired by the wines of Spain. Living in California with its Spanish/Mexican heritage was my inspiration to make wine from Spanish wine grapes. In 2014, I started to work with Cabernet Sauvignon after a client requested a Cabernet Sauvignon based wine. That led me to try my hand at making Cabernet for Verdad, as it's an incredible grape and its wines are some of the most age-worthy wines of the world. In addition up the road from the coast and inland I source Cabernet from Paso Robles. The vineyards offer steep hillsides and limestone and marine fossil rich soils that able to grow stellar Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot along with many other varieties. Los Alamos Canyon (Martian Vineyard) and Santa Ynez Valley (Ibarra-Young Vineyard) are exceptional AVA's that combine both coastal and continental influences. - Louisa Sawyer Lindquist

Cris and JoAnn Cherry moved to Paso Robles in 1996 to open a restaurant, partake in the burgeoning wine scene and raise their children in the country. In 2001, they purchased their first grapes to make wine for their restaurant. And so began Villa Creek Cellars, their best expression of west Paso Robles' Rhone grape varieties.

Today, they farm their own certified biodynamic and certified organic vineyard, the MAHA Estate in the hills west of Paso Robles. They continue to purchase grapes from the region's most esteemed vineyards and strive to create exciting wines that reflect the land from which they originated.

The MAHA Estate is 8 miles west of Paso Robles. Extreme topography of south and west facing slopes that climb to 1800 feet continue to captivate Cris and JoAnn with the dynamic views of the coastal mountain range. The winery was erected in 2003 to house the production of roughly 3000 cases of wine each year. Monterey shale and siliceous shale provide an ideal foundation for the Rhone grape varieties planted in 2012 and 2013. Sustaining the vibrancy and the health of the land by farming the grapes under organic and biodynamic principles will, in turn, make vibrant wines. The soil is abundant in micro organisms and is the perfect host to the vines, the family and their flock of 30 Dorper sheep that graze the vineyard in the winter and spring. The energy of this site is palpable.

Planet Oregon by Soter Vineyards, Willamette Valley - NEW ARRIVAL



Tony Soter is the founder of Soter Vineyards at Mineral Springs Ranch in Yamhill-Carlton, Oregon. Soter is a Portland, Oregon, native who began his remarkable 40-year winemaking career in the Napa Valley. After graduating from Pomona College in southern California with a degree in philosophy, Soter joined the staff at Stag's Leap Wine Cellars in 1975 to learn the trade.

By 1982, he released his own wine under the Etude label, selling the winery almost 20 years later to Treasury Wine Estates. In the meantime, Soter worked as consulting winemaker for such world-famous Napa estates as Araujo (now Eisele), Chappellet, Dalla Valle, Shafer, and Spottswoode, among others. After almost 30 years in California, Soter moved back to Oregon and founded Soter Vineyards in 1997, where he is still making some of the most heralded pinot noirs in the state.

Today, Soter focuses on biodynamic grape growing to create rich flavours and substance. His cellar techniques look to the wisdom of past generations, trusting those natural processes to evoke the voice and character of each vineyard.

Chris has his own wine brand, Figgins, and his latest enterprise as part of the Figgins Family Wine Estates Portfolio is Toil Oregon, a Willamette Valley Pinot Noir. He may be the first eastern Washington winemaker to produce a Willamette Valley Pinot Noir. The wines have already garnered cult status, are only sold through a mailing list and never before exported. The inaugural wine from the 2012 vintage was sourced from Ribbon Ridge (Ridgecrest Vineyard) and Eola-Amity Hills (Schindler Vineyard) AVAs.

WILLAKENZIE

ESTATE

Bernard and Ronni Lacroute purchased a 430-acre ranch in the hills of the Chehalem Valley (Yamhill-Carlton District AVA) in 1991. The site reminded Bernard of his Burgundy origins. They began a programmed planting of the property that same year under the direction of Joel Myers and released their first wines in 1995 after completion of a modern gravity flow winery which was built into a hillside. The name WillaKenzie was chosen from the name of the sedimentary soils common to the Yamhill-Carlton area.

104.5 acres are now planted on hilltops to the Pinot family of grapes and in the mid-2000s the Estate vineyard was supplemented by the 25-acre Jory Vineyard on Red Hills Road in the Dundee Hills. At a combined 130 acres, WillaKenzie is now the largest family vineyard holding in northwestern Oregon. There are a total of 68 acres of Pinot Noir, all planted on WillaKenzie soil trained into an upright, double guyot trellising system. The vineyards have been farmed organically since their origins.

WillaKenzie Estate emphasises sustainable viticulture, clonal and rootstock diversity, estate-grown fruit, and gentle winemaking practices.

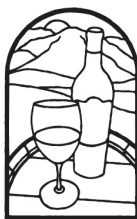
Doubleback, Walla Walla Valley (Washington) - NEW WINES

Josh, also a Walla Walla native, has been named a "Washington Prodigy" and a "Game Changer of Washington Wine" by Wine Enthusiast Magazine. The collaboration between Drew and Josh is a competitive partnership that pushes them to continue the pursuit of perfection in Cabernet Sauvignon every day.

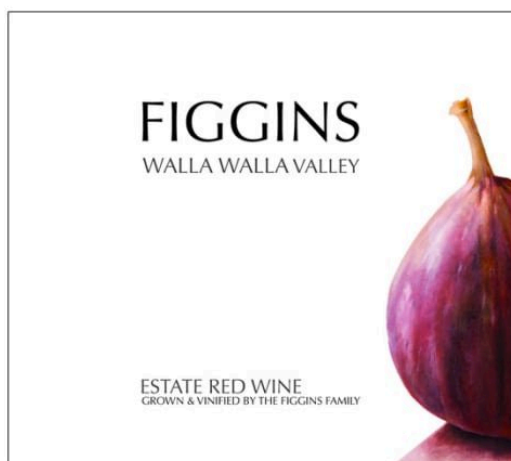
Leonetti Cellar

Leonetti Cellar is one of Walla Walla Valley's pioneering wine producers. It was established in 1977 with plantings of Cabernet Sauvignon and Riesling, and now makes a range of wines from Cabernet, Merlot and Sangiovese. The wines have become recognised globally as among the top Bordeaux varietal expressions. The estate draws upon several key vineyards throughout Walla Walla. These cover a wealth of terroir, on different aspects and slopes, and with a wide range of soil types based on the Valley's silty loam soils. This gives Leonetti the ability to carefully select sites for each variety, and grapes are planted in the vineyards in which they are judged to do best. A couple of blocks in the Seven Hills and Leonetti vineyards have older vines, which are used to make the top wines.

Leonetti Cellar has become one of the region's more premium producers, commanding high prices for its range of mostly Bordeaux-inspired wines. The Reserve Bordeaux Blend has further increased the brand's prestige in recent years, receiving a 100-point score from the famously influential wine critic Robert Parker. **Organic.**

Figgins Estate, Walla Walla Valley (Washington)



Figgins is the project of veteran winemaker Chris Figgins, best known for being the winemaker at his family winery Leonetti Cellar. Although he could easily have been content carrying on Leonetti's stellar track record as one of the best wineries in Washington, Chris wanted a project that would be all his own. With that in mind he created the Figgins vineyard, a 32-acre plot of land in Walla Walla planted to Cabernet, Merlot, and Petite Verdot.

Inspired by the estate wineries of the old world, all of these grapes go into making one wine, with the goal of exploring this single terroir. The winemaking is the same each year and therefore the only variables on this wine are what the vintage provides. The blend changes subtly each year in response to the unique conditions of that season, thus encapsulating and translating a time and place in the way that only wine can do. Chris is the second generation of Walla Walla's first bonded winery, and rather than just holding steady he is intent on refining and improving the already revered reputation of his family. At Figgins and Leonetti, Chris is producing some of the greatest wines in the United States and, though he is already well on his way to a long and venerable career, this is merely the beginning. **Organic.**

Chateau Brown - NEW ARRIVAL

In 2012, Mr. Hubert de Bouïard de Laforest (of Château Angélu) joined forces with Mr. Philippe Nunes, the technical director of his Lalande de Pomerol vineyard, La Fleur de Bouïard. With friends, they acquired a 6.6 hectare estate on a clayey and chalky plateau of Saint Sulpice and Cameyrac, as well as on the gravelly clays of Montussan, a perfect terroir for the culture of Merlot. The vines overhang a small river, La Laurence, from which the estate took its name. These two experts apply their experience to reveal the best expression of this Merlot and to produce an average of 12,000 bottles of Chateau Laurence per year. Like the great growths from Bordeaux, the cellar benefits from stainless steel temperature-controlled vats and the wines are aged for 16 months in French oak barrels. This joint work is a success awarded by flattering comments from the most famous wine critics.

Chateau Cissac - NEW ARRIVAL

Chateau Cissac has been in the hands of the Vialard family since 1895. Chateau Cissac, which takes its name from the commune where it is situated in. The Haut Medoc appellation was created when two vineyards were combined. The grand chateau was built in 1769. The initial purchase of Chateau Martiny by Jacques Mondon which took place in 1895 was enlarged when they purchased Chateau Abiet in 1899. Those two vineyards were brought together to create what we know of as Chateau Cissac today. The vineyard of Chateau Cissac is planted to 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Merlot, and 8% Petit Verdot. The small amount of Malbec previously planted has been removed. The 50-hectare Left Bank vineyard of Chateau Cissac is located in the northern part of the appellation, not too distant from the border of the Pauillac and St. Estephe appellations.

Chateau Campillot - NEW ARRIVAL

A blend of mostly Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, split equally, with 2% each of Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. The vines are closely planted and are on average over 25 years old. Showing a classic Médoc character, the grapes for the wine are pressed in an old vertical press and after small, relatively low temperature batch fermentations, the wines are aged in French oak: 20% new.

Chateau Laurence - NEW ARRIVALS

In 2012, Mr. Hubert de Bouïard de Leforest (of Château Angélu) joined forces with Mr. Philippe Nunes, the technical director of his Lalande de Pomerol vineyard, La Fleur de Bouïard. With friends, they acquired a 6.6 hectare estate on a clayey and chalky plateau of Saint Sulpice and Cameyrac, as well as on the gravelly clays of Montussan, a perfect terroir for the culture of Merlot. The vines overhang a small river, La Laurence, from which the estate took its name. These two experts apply their experience to reveal the best expression of this Merlot and to produce an average of 12,000 bottles of Chateau Laurence per year. Like the great growths from Bordeaux, the cellar benefits from stainless steel temperature-controlled vats and the wines are aged for 16 months in French oak barrels. This joint work is a success awarded by flattering comments from the most famous wine critics.

Chateau Brillette, Moulis en Medoc

Château Brillette is one of the most famous vineyards in the Moulis appellation. As early as 1874, it was presented as one of the best estates in the appellation in the famous Féret guide to Bordeaux and its wines. Located in the heart of the Médoc on the left bank of the Gironde estuary, between Saint-Julien and Margaux, the Moulis appellation is the oldest of the Médoc AOCs. Narrow strip 12km long by 300 to 400m wide, it is also the smallest of the Médoc appellations (600 ha in production). Its wines are appreciated by connoisseurs for their complex bouquet and their aromatic expression: fresh red fruits, vanilla, liquorice.
